4. Quantify the need for more police staff and protection, and introduce measures to remedy the lack of parking at the Court/Police headquarters.
5. Develop a comprehensive land-use policy with a stricter “McMansions” law that protects open space and optimizes land use.
6. Review current budgets and work with village and unincorporated Greenburgh leaders to evaluate services needed, and to ensure fair, legal, equitable budgetary

I will make these changes. I will help give you a Greenburgh we can afford to live in. A Greenburgh we can be proud of.

My loyalties are anchored in bedrock Democratic Party values I believe you share. This includes a firm, unqualified commitment to a woman's right to choose. Inclusiveness. Villages and unincorporated area working cooperatively. An independent Town Board, without financial campaign ties. Checks and balances are the strength of this country and will be assured in Greenburgh under my leadership. And I will continue my long commitment to open space and conservation.
